COMPLEXITIES OF SEX TRAFFICKING

ACTIVITY 4.1 SEX TRAFFICKING SIMULATION

Students increase their understanding of lack of choices and consequences. choose different presented options

Arrange students – This activity can either be completed as one large group or in smaller groups.

ACTIVITY 4.2 IDEA MUSEUM: SEX TRAFFICKING TODAY

Arrange Students – Student's work independently.

Student Instructions

- Students write on individual sticky notes one or more of their ideas on what they think modern-day sex trafficking looks like – examples of individual cases of vulnerabilities paired with entrapment tactics, described in one or two sentences.
- Students put their ideas on the designated wall, then walk around and look at their classmates' answers.
- Then, in class discussion, talk about these ideas critically, especially whether the ideas (in)accurately represent how modern-day sex trafficking happens around the world.

Optional— After discussing ideas, do an image search of “sex trafficking on the internet and discuss what aspects are missing from the images.
